- Apply certifications toward an A.S. degree at Valencia College
- Enroll in classes offered online and study from home

## Steps to Earn Your College Credits

- 1 Talk with a Career Program Advisor.
- 2 Meet regular college entrance requirements.
- 3 Submit a college application and pay the admission fee (you must start Valencia College within 3 years of having completed your certification).
- 4 Declare a major in the Supervision and Management for Industry A.S. degree program.
- 5 Be certified in the industry of study.
- 6 Comply with course prerequisites and other requirements of the college.
- 7 Complete one semester (full or part time) with a "C" or above at Valencia College.
- 8 Bring the certificate of completion to a Career Program Advisor upon completion of your first semester.
- 9 The dean and program chair will evaluate your record, and determine acceptable credits to be transferred and awarded.

Computer Numerical Control Machinist (460 hours) .....	12 credits
Welding I and 2 (1050 hours) .....	24 credits
