8 Weeks and Dual Credit

- Students working towards an Associate's Degree take advantage of 8 week web offerings each semester. These sections are not marked specifically for dual credit.
- Taking an 8 week dual credit class allows a student to experience 8 weeks in high school. This makes their transition to KC easier.

8 Weeks and Dual Credit

- High Schools want college schedules to fit within their high school schedules. At most places, 8 week does not fit within A/B Day schedules, schedules with 50 minute periods, and other unique schedules.
- In cases where KC uses an adjunct/embedded instructor, there is more freedom as to the number of hours and sections they can teach with 16 week courses as opposed to 8 week courses.
