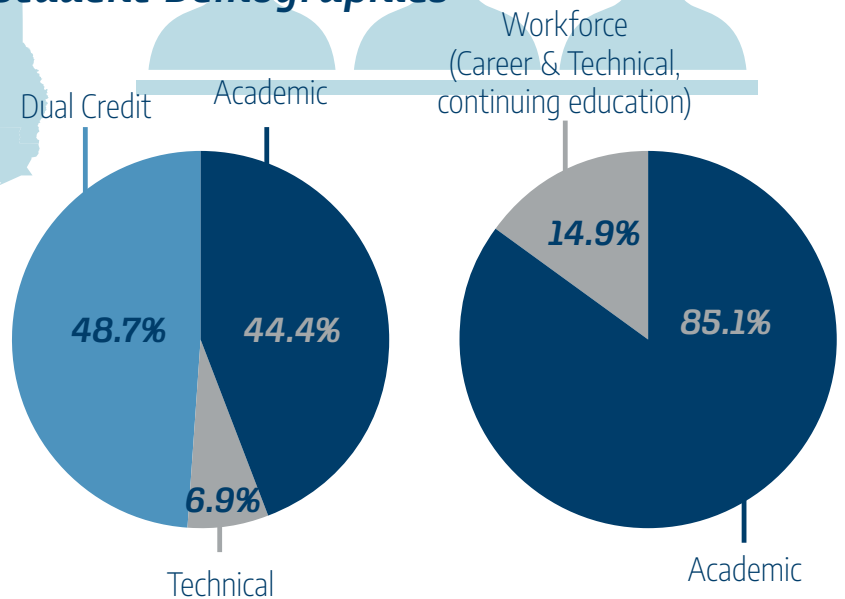
Signature Programs

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Associate of Applied Science (51.091) Program passing, retention, and job placement rates have remained outstanding over the past five years.

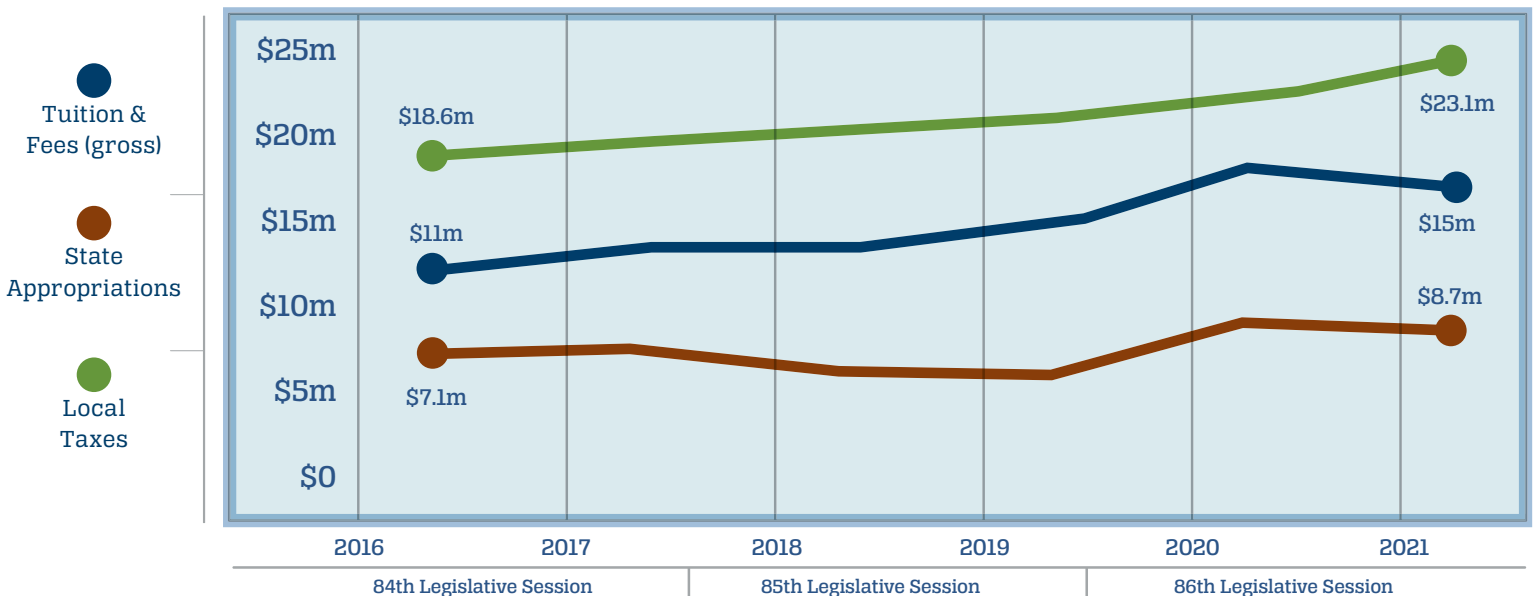
Structural Welding (48.0508) Program graduated over 500 students in two years with new Welding Lab.
