




Average Confidence in Major Institutions




Confidence in Higher Education

Percentage of U.S. Adults with a "Great Deal" or "Quite a Lot" of Confidence in Higher Education











Higher Education in the Early 21st Century



COVID-19 Calling Campaign





Students have the option to unenroll from any of their courses this spring and elect to retake the course at a later date. Students who elect this option will have a grade on their transcript of R20 (more details about the grade can be found online here). Students who register for the same course(s) in summer 2020 will automatically have tuition and fees for those courses waived. The R20 grade does not affect a student's GPA nor does it count as a course attempt. To elect this option, students should contact advising@valenciacollege.edu by Friday, April 17, 2020.

Valencia College Student Poll: Impact of Pandemic

About 20% of Valencia Students were infected with COVID-19

If we include infected household members, 31% of student households had at least one infected member in the household.

40% suffered food insecurity

40% of Valencia students were unable to buy adequate amounts of food during the COVID-19 pandemic due to financial reasons.

Over 1/3rd lost their jobs

Over 1/3 of Valencia Students lost their jobs due to the pandemic and 60% had their hours reduced.

Almost half had financial difficulties

Almost half of Valencia students found it difficult to pay for college during the COVID-19 pandemic.

68% of employed students are essential workers

They work in grocery stores, retail chains, food delivery, healthcare support etc.

30% needed to stay home and take care of children

16% of Students had to stop working to take care of children due to COVID-19. Around 30% of Valencia students had to spend most of their time educating children in their home.

Students are pessimistic about the future

Students have lots of worries about family members falling ill and new COVID variants slowing the return to "normal." Students are very pessimistic on the economy's return and the job market improving in the new year.









College Access Goal: Progress Through 2021


Percentage of Students Enrolled in Florida Postsecondary Institution in Year Following High School Graduation

Percentage of Degree-Seeking Students Who Completed an Associate Degree within Five Years by Incoming Cohort




You CAN accomplish your goals, and so many Valencia College students are proof of that.

Graduation Goal Leading Indicator: First 15 Credit Hours


Percentage of Students Who Complete 15 College-Level Credit Hours Within Two Years by Incoming Cohort






Impact of the DirectConnect to UCF Pathway

Percentage of Students Completing UCF or Valencia Baccalaureate Degree Within Four Years of Matriculating After Completing AA or AS


