### Learning Framework Stats

- •Enrolled 1959 students in LF from F19-F22 (69% PC, 31% DC)
- •Started 32% online and 68% F2F; now 64% online, 36% F2F
- •Average grade F2F 84, online 79
- Low withdrawal rate of 5%
- •84% finish course with a C or above
- •170 DC students finished a degree or certificate from F19-F22 (28%)




