

Starting Strong: Improving College Onboarding for Student Achievement

Degree-seeking, first time in college and dual credit students are enrolling in classes without clear admissions and career advising or immersive orientation prior to selecting their career pathway.

Proposed Changes:



Broad Redesign

Implement Caring Campus program with both staff and faculty



Targeted Redesign

Onboarding structured around the ACIP framework

Ask:

- Basic Needs Questionnaire added to application
- Welcome call to all incoming students
- Intake Survey & Career Assessment

Connect:

- Mandatory orientations organized around meta-majors
 - Faculty & Community/Employers included
 - Student panels included

Inspire:

- First Year Experience implemented
 - Learning communityvies organized by meta-major
- Experiential learning opportunities added to Learning Frameworks
- "Light the Fire" course in first term without TSI prerequisites

Plan:

- Caseloads organized by meta-majors
- Credentialing as Certified Career Services Providers
- Embedded dual credit advisors

Expected Outcomes · ·

- Increased persistence rates [Term 1 to Term 2]
- Increased persistence rates [Year 1 to Year 2]
- Reduction in excess credits
- Clear alignment of coursework with a selected career pathway
- Increased social mobility

Implementation Timeline

Summer 2024

- Basic needs questionnaire developed
- Intake survey and career assessment completed
- Faculty/employers included in orientation

Fall 2024

- Restructure onboarding staff
- Begin Career credentialing of advisors
- Develop First Year Experience (FYE)

Spring 2025

- Learning Frameworks revised to include experiential learning
- Academic Council approves "Light the Fire" courses

Summer 2025

- Orientations fully by meta-major
- Launch FYE
- Catalog updated to include "Light the Fire" Courses

Fall 2025

- Advising staff fully credentialed
- FYE learning communities implemented
- First enrollments in "Light the fire" courses
