Community College Association of Texas Trustees Sponsorship Program

The Community College Association of Texas Trustees (CCATT) provides high-value professional development and policy insights for effective leadership for Texas community college trustees and regents. The association works with educators, organizations, and community leaders from across Texas who bring the passion and expertise needed to produce these programs.

Community Colleges in Texas

With 50 independently governed public community colleges across the state, partnering with CCATT means supporting meaningful collaboration for higher education governance in Texas. Below are a few highlights from the [2025 Fact Sheet](#) about the impact of community colleges:

- Serving more than 700,000 students, Texas community colleges represent the largest sector of higher education in the state.
- 70% of all freshmen and sophomores in Texas higher education are enrolled at a community college.
- Texas community colleges award 96% of all Career & Technical Education (CTE) degrees and certificates.
- They are ranked as the 5th most affordable public two-year college tuition and fees in the nation.

CCATT events provide high-value content and high-touch interactions among Texas community college trustees and leaders. We will select a limited number of event sponsors who want to find avenues to bring value to our conversations and future events. Members of the CCATT Board and Resource Committee will act as hosts and facilitate introductions for sponsors to meet other Texas community college leaders during the event.

At the Annual Conference, sponsors will have extensive opportunities to interact with trustees and regents as they engage in professional development and strategic planning to improve community college governance and student success outcomes. For your benefit, we provide ample time for sponsors to engage in conversations during breaks, breakfast, lunch, and an evening reception. We also encourage attendees to visit with sponsors during breaks and meals. A new addition this year is *Tables & Treats*, designated space on the agenda after lunch on Friday, September 18, when all sponsors will have the opportunity to network with attendees over post-lunch desserts and refreshments. The CCATT Annual Conference Sponsorship Package options include the benefits listed above, formal acknowledgements at Opening and Closing Plenary Sessions, and more based on the different levels outlined on the following page.



2026 Sponsorship Levels

Diamond – \$15,000 Conference Sponsorship

The Diamond Sponsor package includes the aforementioned benefits plus a 5-minute welcome during the Opening Plenary Session. This company serves as the Internet and AV sponsor for the entire conference. When possible, we will use your company name as the password for Internet access (e.g. Diamond_Architects) for added name recognition. The Diamond Sponsor has the largest branding size in our conference sponsorship listing and program.

Ruby – \$10,000 Conference Sponsorship

The Ruby Sponsor partners with CCATT on a breakout session or serves as a breakfast, lunch, or reception sponsor with appropriate signage from the company displayed and the opportunity to briefly welcome attendees. The Ruby Sponsor has the second largest branding size in sponsorship listing on the sponsor slide and conference program. There are eight different options for a Ruby sponsor to formally address attendees: three meals (not including the Dinner & Opening Plenary); one reception; and four breakout sessions, presented in partnership with a Texas community college. Breakout sessions must be proposed by submitting [this form](#) before **May 13, 2026**, and are subject to approval by the CCATT Education Committee.

Emerald – \$7,000 Conference Sponsorship

The Emerald Sponsor serves as a snack break sponsor with appropriate signage from the company displayed. This sponsor has the third largest branding size on the sponsor slide and conference program.

Sapphire – \$5,000 Conference Sponsorship

The Sapphire Sponsor is the basic sponsorship level, allowing your team to participate in the conference and receive recognition as a sponsor in communications to our membership prior to the event. This sponsor has the fourth largest branding size on the sponsor slide and conference program.

Exhibition Opportunity

For sponsors at all levels, your team will have the option to host an exhibit booth or table during the CCATT Annual Conference. This will provide additional opportunities to educate attendees on the services available through strategic partnerships. Table sizes and locations are subject to approval and based on availability, and additional costs may be incurred from the hotel for furniture and equipment set-up. Higher level sponsors may have the option for larger exposition space and will receive preferential placement. The sponsor exhibition will take place on **Friday, September 18 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM** to allow interactions throughout the day as attendees transition between plenary and concurrent sessions. Sponsors may attend all conference sessions, except the First-Time Attendees Luncheon and Chairs Council Meeting.
