March 5-7, 2016

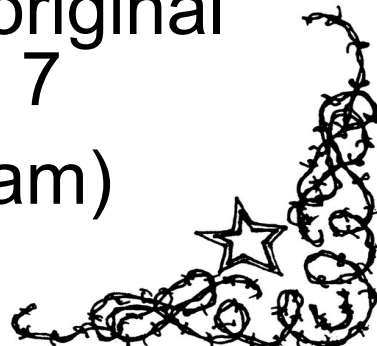
Intercontinental Dallas (Addison)

(notify the Center ASAP if you plan to bring more than 1 team)



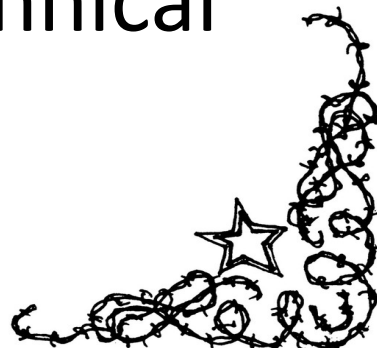

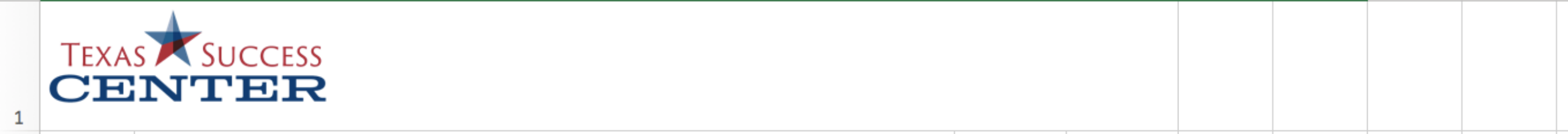
