From Fall 2017 to Fall 2018:

- Average prices per semester credit hour (SCH) were up over two percent on average for all student types;
- At 4.7%, the largest increase was in non-resident tuition, and tuition was the largest source of price growth for all student groups;
- In-district resident students continued to experience the lowest average prices, paying about 63% of the average out-of-district price per SCH and about 45% of the average non-resident price per SCH;
- Student fees decreased on average for all student groups and had the largest decrease for non-resident students.

- While student fees decreased on average for all student groups from Fall 2017 to Fall 2018, fees have seen the largest percentage increase over the last ten years for all student groups.
- On average, colleges charge more in total to non-residents than out-of-district students, and more to out-of-district students than in-district students; however, non-residents have consistently paid lower fees on average than out-of-district students.
- The price gaps between in-district, out-of-district, and non-resident students have been mostly consistent over the last ten years. In Fall 2008, an out-of-district student paid about 1.5x the total price per SCH, on average, of an in-district student, and a non-resident paid about 2.2x the in-district price. In Fall 2018, those ratios were about 1.6x and 2.2x, respectively.
