- *Closed equity gaps in three-year graduation and transfer rates over the last five years*
 - *Growth Rate in 3-year Graduation Rates (42% All Students; 43% Black; 53% Hispanic; 40% Pell Recipient; and 30% First Generation)*
 - *Growth Rate in 3-year Transfer Rates (10% All Students; 225% Black; 40% Hispanic; 29% Pell Recipient; and 11% First Generation)*

- *Doubled completion rates over the last five years*
