Why?

The social determinants of health, which we can study using the rich labor market and demographic data created throughout the United States, help to better explain why certain regions have seen a bigger impact from COVID-19 while others have gone relatively unscathed.

Understanding the current state?


- Know their unique situation. The virus poses unique risks to different communities, and requires local responses.
- Build more fine-tuned strategies. Protecting the most vulnerable while also keeping the economy intact is a more sustainable way forward.
- Communicate and lead. People desire good information and leadership that has a clear plan and justification for that plan.
- Data for better decisions (vs predictive models)
- Local decisions (vs blunt force response)
- Action (vs lockdown)

Data to help us navigate: Social Determinants of Health


Risk Index for COVID-19 ...!



- 1. Preconditioned population: The number of people who, within the past year, have been treated for diabetes, visited a cardiologist, taken asthma medications, or smoked.
- 2. Population density: The number of people per square mile in the region.
- **3. Workplace interaction:** A measure of the overall workplace density of specific industries.
- 4. **Population health:** The age, income, and education level of the region's population, which affect their overall health.

2. Results: Texas

The social determinants of health indicate that New York, Los Angeles, and Milwaukee have a higher risk than cities like Seattle, etc.

HEALTH RISK INDEX: Overall location-based COVID-19 risk, calculated from all four risk indices below



Application

- 1. Risk can be managed and understood but not eliminated
- 2. Risk analysis is a guide (data helps us make better decisions)
- 3. Solutions should be local
- 4. Interdisciplinary data is a must (multiple perspectives)



1. Local and state governments and institutions

- State and local leaders use this risk analysis to understand their biggest risk factors and develop fine-tuned strategies that limit risk for the most vulnerable places and people.
- Help planners determine future potential hotspots, so that reemployment efforts aren't derailed by new outbreaks.

2. Business

- Evaluate their locations, the level of social interaction in the workplace, and the health of their workforce.
 - A recent poll indicates that 54% of US employees are concerned about exposure to COVID-19 at work, but 71% also feel confident their employer can manage the back-towork transition safely.
- For employees to feel safe, they need to know their employer has taken measured steps to mitigate viral outbreaks.

3. Individuals

- Help individual Americans make better decisions, minimizing the need for the government to step in.
- People should know the data, weigh the risks, and make smarter decisions for themselves.


